Hunza Trip ... Exploring History & Beauty

Date: 18th - 23rd June 2025


Trips to Pakistan's Northern Areas are always exhilarating and educational, and ours combined breathtaking adventure with cultural discovery.

During this memorable journey, we are also sharing brief insights about each famous historical location we visited, so you know why these places are so important and iconic!

Karakoram Highway (Besham | Dasu | Chilas | Hunza)


Known as the **"Eighth Wonder of the World"**, this highway took 20 years to build, from 1962 to 1979. It opened to public traffic in 1986 with heavy Chinese-Pakistani collaboration, tragically costing over 1,000 lives from landslides and falling rock.

It follows the route of the ancient Silk Road, once used by traders and explorers.



Glacier River, Nagar







Around Chilas, you can spot ancient rock carvings and Buddhist petroglyphs, dating from 5000 BCE to 1000 AD, which prove the region's ancient cultural and religious significance.

Hunza Valley


A former princely state until 1974, Hunza has always been culturally rich and strategically important. Surrounded by the Himalayas and Karakoram, Hunza has been influenced by Tibetan, Persian, and Central Asian civilizations. It's not only known for its beauty, but also the longevity and hospitality of its people.


Hooper Valley, Nagar

Located across the river from Hunza, Hooper Valley offers stunning views of Rakaposhi, Pakistan's 12th-highest peak. Though not commercialized, its serene landscapes and cultural simplicity make it historically and environmentally significant

Attabad Lake & Friendship Tunnels

This turquoise lake was formed by a massive landslide in January 2010, which tragically buried villages and blocked the Hunza River. As a result, new infrastructure was needed. China and Pakistan built the Pak-China Friendship Tunnels—a series of five long tunnels that are a symbol of resilience, international cooperation, and infrastructure achievement.







Hussaini Suspension Bridge

Originally located in Shishkat, it was moved to Hussaini Village in 1967–68 by the order of Mir Muhammad Jamal Khan.


Spanning nearly 660 feet across the Borit River, it is built with wooden planks and wire cables.

Today, it's considered one of the most **dangerous suspension bridges in the world**, and crossing it is a thrilling, unforgettable experience!













Rainbow Bridge

Though not historical, this beautiful footbridge near Passu is decorated in vibrant colors and offers views of the river and mountain ranges. It reflects local creativity and is perfect for photos!

Passu Cones (Passu Cathedral)

These iconic, jagged mountain peaks are part of the Karakoram Range. Their unique, pointed shapes have made them worldfamous among hikers, climbers, and photographers. They symbolize the rugged beauty of Hunza and are visible from miles away.





























Altit & Baltit Forts

Altit Fort is over 900 years old, the oldest surviving structure in Gilgit-Baltistan. It was home to the ruling Mirs of Hunza and offers breathtaking views of the valley.

Baltit Fort, about 700 years old, is built in a Tibetan-inspired style. After restoration by the Aga Khan Trust, it now serves as a museum and a reminder of Hunza's royal past.

Lady Finger Peak (Bublimotin)

A slim, pointed peak beside the Ultar Sar range, it's named for its shape, like a lady's finger pointing at the sky.

It's not only a climbing challenge but also considered sacred in local folklore, often visible in clear skies above Hunza.


Babusar Pass & Naran-Kaghan Route

At 13,700 feet, Babusar Top connects Hunza to Naran-Kaghan through dramatic views and alpine valleys.

Historically, this route served as a trade and migration passage between Kashmir, Gilgit, and beyond—used by merchants, travelers, and tribes over centuries.



I completed my BSCS (Bachelor of Science in Computer Science) from the Arid Agriculture University in 2018, which laid the academic foundation for my professional journey.

How It All Started

My tech career officially began at Creatrix, located in Bahria Phase 4, where I spent 2 years learning the ropes of mobile development. This experience was pivotal in shaping my skills and giving me real-world exposure.

After that, I joined the National Information Technology Board (NITB), where I had the opportunity to work on several impactful government projects. A few notable ones include:
